

Itinerary for *Island Princess*[®]

Below is the itinerary for the cruise portion of the tour.

- August 8** Fly from home to Seattle, Washington. Overnight in Seattle.
- August 9** 10:00AM board the motor coach at Seattle airport for the ride to Vancouver, British Columbia
4:30PM our cruise ship Island Princess departs Vancouver
- August 10** Cruise along Canadian Pacific shore
- August 11** Ketchikan, Alaska Arrive 6:30AM Depart 2:00PM
- August 12** Juneau, Alaska Arrive 8:00AM Depart 9:00PM
- August 13** Skagway, Alaska Arrive 7:00AM Depart 8:30PM
- August 14** Glacier Bay National Park, Alaska (Scenic Cruising)
Arrive 6:00AM Depart 3:00PM
- August 15** College Fjord, Alaska (Scenic Cruising) Arrive 5:30PM Depart 8:30PM
- August 16** Anchorage (Whittier), Alaska Arrive 12:30AM but do not depart ship until after breakfast.

There are dozens of shore excursions that you can choose from at each port. The Princess website gives you a description and cost of each. You also have the choice to do any activity on your own.

Below is the itinerary for the land portion of the tour.

- August 16** Whittier/Denali
Disembark your ship in Whittier, AK and board the Denali Express at the dock for direct rail service to Denali National Park. Check into the Denali Princess Wilderness Lodge for a 2-night retreat.
- August 17** Denali
Enjoy a morning at leisure than take an afternoon Natural History Tour into Denali National Park. Enjoy the rest of the day relaxing at the lodge or choose one of the optional excursions available from the Tour Desk.
- August 18** Denali/Fairbanks
After a morning of leisure, enjoy a scenic motorcoach journey to Fairbanks. Take a cruise on an authentic Sternwheeler Riverboat down the Chena River. Overnight in Fairbanks.
- August 19** Fairbanks/Seattle
Fly from Fairbanks to Seattle and check into an airport area hotel.
- August 20** Seattle
Your tour ends today with a flight home.
